Learning Activity (Description in Steps)

Abstract (limit 100 characters): The kids use their sense of sight to find hidden objects.

Details: Begin the lesson by asking the class what part of the body they see with. Prior to beginning the game, it is important to assign each student (or group) an object so they won't pick up someone else's item. It is also good to write down what you assigned to each student and check them off when they bring it back so they won't cheat. It is also suggested that the student repeat the object back to you so they will know what they are looking for.
