The PhD consists of 45 hours and is designed for student flexibility in selecting course work. Courses are selected with approval from graduate committee. The program of study should consist of 16 or more hours of 8000- and 9000-level courses in addition to research, dissertation writing, and directed study. Students may not take more than 6 hours of special problems, internships, directed study, or field experience toward the degree. Cumulative GPA must be 3.0 or higher. D and F grades will not be accepted as part of a program of study for a graduate degree.
